GÜLOR SIGNATURE SAUVIGNON BLANC 2023

This Sauvignon Blanc wine is made by grapes harvested from our 30 years old Şarköy Vineyard. Fermented and aged on lees for 6 months in steel tanks. Alcohol content is % 11,7 by volume.

GÜLOR SIGNATURE SEMILLON 2022

This wine is made by grapes harvested from more than 50 years old vineyards from Şarköy Region. Fermented and aged on lees in steel tanks for 6 months before bottling. Alcohol content is % 13,3 by volume.

GÜLOR SIGNATURE ROZE 2023

This wine is made by grapes harvested from 30 years old vineyard situated around our vinery at Eriklice/Şarköy. Fermented and aged on lees for 6 months in steel tank before bottling. Alcohol content is % 12,2 by volume.

THE BRIDGE ÖKÜZGÖZÜ-MALBEC 2021

This wine is a blend of Öküzgözü (65%) grapes from Elazığ/Balıbey Region and Malbec (35%) from our vineyard situated in Eriklice/Şarköy. Fermented in steel tanks and aged in % 20 new French oak for 8 months. Alcohol content is % 12,3 by volume.

GÜLOR SIGNATURE MALBEC 2022

This wine is made by grapes coming from our Malbec vineyards situated in Eriklice/Şarköy. Fermented in steel tanks and aged in % 30 new French oak for 8 months. Alcohol content is % 13,6 by volume.

COT'N 2020

This wine is made by grapes coming from our vineyards situated in Şarköy, fermented in steel tanks and aged in % 50 new French oak for 12 months. Contains % 70 Malbec, % 20 Petit Verdot and % 10 Merlot. Alcohol content is % 13,7 by volume.
